Danish [SimpleSite](#), a service that enables users to build their own websites with ease and simplicity, has won [Red Herring](#) Global award. The company's CEO, Morten Elk, represented the company at the ceremony in Los Angeles, USA.

For SimpleSite, running several million active free websites and about 100,000 paying customers, the Red Herring Global award was important in terms of finding investors who can support the company's future growth.
